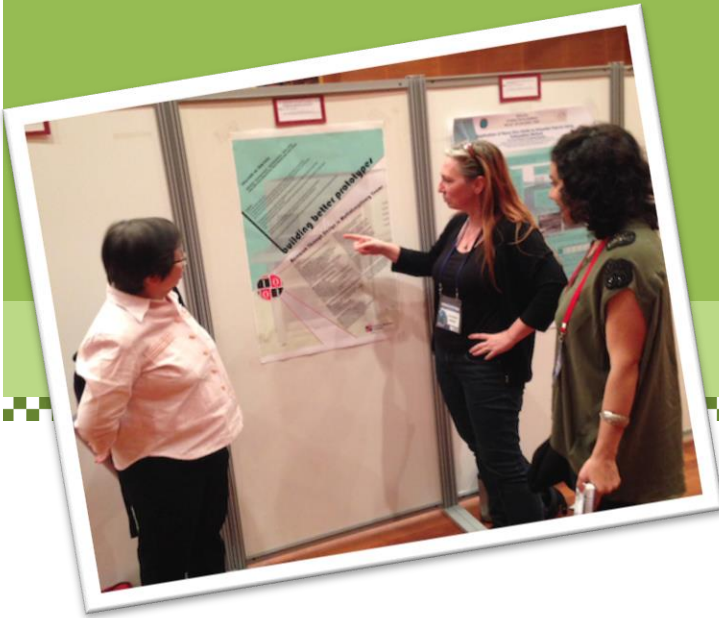

I am currently representing DWN in the US as support for sales, installation and training for the TC-2 and TC-1. I spent a year in Norway working closely with DWN and the DWN team training under the support crew. I also travelled and trained new customers on their looms as well.

Thoughts about the TC2

The TC-2 allows the weaver, artist, designer, researcher, etc.... to do what he/she wants. The TC-2 is a tool that gives the user more freedom and ability to expand what they thought possible, and even to try things he/she hadn't considered before because of the difficulty or complications associated with other types of looms or loom arrangements (cost, travel....etc).

I have woven nearly 100,000 picks on the TC-2 and I am very satisfied - excited actually to have a loom that can perform so well. The advances in design and function that DWN performed in their redesign of the TC-2 has vastly improved the performance of a loom that was already far and away better than any other loom I have worked on.

About Cathryn

I currently teach at Eastern Michigan University. I received my MFA in Textiles in 2005. I worked very closely with Pat Williams supporting her Jacquard Certificate program. Since then, I have managed and maintained the 2 TC-1 looms located in the Art Department of our university. I have held artist residencies at Oriole Mill in North Carolina, have travelled to Montreal to train with Louise Lemeiux Berube, and had some training from Eva Basile (of Lisio). I recently completed a year long sabbatical in Norway where I resided as Artist in residence at Tronrud Engineering. I used this time to research and develop my own work and weaves as well as to train on the service and maintenance of the TC-2.
